

Accreditation offered

At Key Stages 4 and 5 all student progress and achievement is recognised through the awarding of a range of nationally recognised external accreditation. This includes OCR and Assessment and Qualifications Authority (AQA) entry level qualifications, ASDAN and AQA unit award schemes.

Accreditation is offered at the following three levels for all areas of study: experiential, intermediate and advanced. Each student, for each area of study, has an identified level of accreditation they are following. This is referred to as the student's 'progression pathway'. The level of accreditation a student will follow may vary depending on the area of study, i.e. they may follow an accredited course at advanced level in mathematics, but an intermediate level accreditation in English.
