Trinity Solutions Academy's Learn to Work programme is a roll-on, roll-off course with a strong vocational focus for 16-19 year olds. We also offer bespoke packages to young people aged 16-25 who have an Education Health and Care Plan which includes Preparation for Adulthood.

All students can gain qualifications up to Level 2 in industries such as Motor Vehicle, Hair, Beauty and Barbering, Construction, Teaching Assistant, Business Administration, Land Based Studies, Health and Social Care as well as undertaking work-based training in Highways or Pathways Maintenance. Students are also able to study towards their English and Maths qualifications, from Functional Skills up to GCSE, and develop their knowledge of PSD through creative and engaging weekly classroom sessions.

Though we are unable to present to you in person we want to still give you the experience and information from an open event online. The virtual event will allow you to ask any

questions you may have about our apprenticeships, full-time and part-time courses that we will offer for September 2020.
