

Painted Elephant Biscuits

Ingredients

110g (4oz) butter or margarine

110g (4oz) soft brown sugar

1 egg

225g (8oz) plain flour

1 pinch of salt

1 tsp mixed spice

For decorating

food colouring

cotton buds

Equipment

a large mixing bowl

a sieve

a teaspoon & tablespoon

a wooden spoon

elephant cutter

boards and rolling pins

a cup

scales

baking trays & wire rack

This recipe makes approximately 20 biscuits.

Method

- 1. Pre-heat the oven to 190°C (375F) gas mark 5.
- 2. Mix the butter and sugar in the bowl until smooth and creamy.
- 3. Crack the egg into the cup, then add it to the mixture and stir well.
- 4. Sift theflour, salt and mixed spice and mix toform a dough.
- 5. Sprinkle some flour on a board or clean work surface.
- 6. Take some of the dough and roll out until about 5mm thick.
- 7. Cut out elephant shapes and lift carefully onto baking trays.
- 8. Bake for about 15 minutes until golden brown.
- 9. Cool on a wire tray.

Decorating the biscuits:

- Mix some food colouring with a little water in a small bowl.
- 11. Use the cotton buds to paint decorations on the biscuits. or
- 12. Decorate with icing and sprinkles.
